




Fact Sheet for Reciprocal Clubs

DINING FACILITIES

MEMBER'S DINING ROOM - FIRST FLOOR

A traditional buffet lunch is served every Monday to Friday from 12.30 pm to 2.00 pm in the Members' Dining Room.

The Members' Dining Room is open to all Club Members and Sponsored Members of Reciprocal Clubs, who may invite one gentlemen guest to accompany them over lunch. A reservation is not required when dining in the Members' Dining Room and dress is jacket and tie.

For those gentlemen who would like a pre-lunch refreshment, the Members' Bar is open on the First Floor from 12 noon.

BAR SERVICES IN THE NORMAN COWPER ROOM (FIRST FLOOR)

Bar Services are available in the Norman Cowper Room and provides a dedicated and attractive destination within the Club for Members to enjoy an extensive drinks menu and converse with friends in the charm of the Norman Cowper Room.

MEMBERS' BAR

Monday - Friday Saturday - Sunday

12.00 noon – 5.00 pm Closed

Bar services will be provided in the Norman Cowper Room to Members and their gentlemen guests. During this time, the dress requirement of jacket and tie will be strictly followed.

COCKTAIL BAR

Monday - Saturday Sunday

5.00 pm - 10.00 pm Closed

The bar in the Norman Cowper Room transforms to an evening cocktail bar providing unique and dedicated bar services to comfortably entertain lady and gentlemen guests for pre- and post-dinner drinks. The dress requirement during the evenings is jacket with ties optional.

Between the hours of 5pm and 7pm (Monday to Saturday), Members and guests may enjoy complimentary canapes to accompany their beverage of choice. As well, on Friday and Saturday evenings, live music will be introduced as performers grace the Norman Cowper Room and bring the bar to life.

WRITING ROOM (FIRST FLOOR)

Monday to Sunday: Continuous

The Writing Room will be exclusively available to Members only. Members may order refreshments from the Norman Cowper Room, whilst it is in operation, to enjoy in the Writing Room.

THE CELLAR DOOR - BENT STREET DRIVEWAY

A selection of wines, spirits and beer are available for purchase, with a home delivery service available to any location in Australia. Members may also purchase or hire glassware, ice, and bar equipment for private external events. Orders and enquiries may be placed with the Cellar Manager.



ACCOMMODATION

CLUB

The Club has 32 accommodation rooms, including four suites, 19 double rooms and 9 single rooms all of which were refurbished in recent times. The double rooms are available with twin, queen or king size beds. Each room is equipped with a private bathroom, remote control LCD television with cable and free to air channels, telephone, modem line, access to wireless broadband, clock radio, personal bar, tea and coffee making facilities and an electronic safe.

Accommodation is available for Members and their wives, immediate family members accompanied by a Member, visitors from overseas and members of reciprocal clubs. (Refer to By-laws 43 and 44 for more details).

MACQUARIE SUITES

Macquarie Suites offers premium accommodation in the form of 6 serviced suites with kitchenette.

The accommodation has been designed to create more flexibility for Members and their family. Interconnecting rooms and the one and two-bedroom suites encourage longer stays. Members may make reservations for invited guests. These guests do not need to be accompanied by the Member.

DRESS CODE

Members and gentlemen guests should wear a long-sleeved jacket and tie when in the Club with the following exceptions:

On the First Floor

A tie is optional after 5.00 pm, when attending the bar in the Norman Cowper Room. A tie is optional on a Saturday, Sunday, or on Public Holidays.

On the Third Floor Only

The dress requirements for the third floor are jacket with optional tie at all times.

Members using the Fitness Centre, are required to follow the dress code requirements as set out in the Fitness Centre Guidelines.

Club Functions

When attending pre-rugby functions, gentlemen are not required to wear a tie and may wear a jacket suited for comfort and warmth. A rugby jersey is permitted when attending a rugby event.

The dress code for gentlemen may be amended as appropriate to the nature of the function if designated by the House Committee.

Members and guests in residence may dress in clothing appropriate to their destination, when entering or departing the Clubhouse.

Ladies

Ladies may wear a dress, skirt, tailored trousers, or evening pants as part of their attire in all parts of the Club at all times.

Active wear (including casual leggings) may not be worn in any of the dining rooms or bars without specific approval by the House Committee prior.

Neither gentlemen nor ladies may wear denim attire in the Club at any time, except under the provisions of By-law 14(d) and (f).

Members should refer to By-laws 14 & 15 for more information on dress requirements within the Clubhouse.



PRIVATE FUNCTIONS

The Club can cater for breakfasts, luncheons, dinners, weddings, cocktail receptions, card functions, anniversaries and birthdays and Members are encouraged to use the Club's private function rooms. The rooms are known as the Private Dining Room, Macleay Room and Merewether Room. Additionally, private functions can be held in the Cellar Door and in the Library in the evening. Members need to be aware to accommodate the use of the Cedar room for private functions, the fine dining will be moved to the Macleay Room.

Restricted access to the Writing Room, Norman Cowper Room and the Members' Dining Room on the First floor is also possible, subject to review by the House Committee.

THE CELLAR DOOR – LOWER GROUND LEVEL

The Cellar Door is available for private functions between 5 pm until 11 pm Monday to Saturday. Application can also be made to host a luncheon.

No one under the age of 18 may be entertained in the Cellar Door.

THE MEMBERS' DINING ROOM – FIRST FLOOR

This room is available to Members, subject to review by the House Committee, for private functions during the evening, Monday – Saturday and for lunchtime receptions on a Saturday.

THE PRIVATE DINING ROOM – SECOND FLOOR

Views from the room are across Macquarie Street to the Botanic Gardens.

Views from this room are across the Harbour and Botanic Gardens.

Luncheon and Dinner 48 guests Cocktail Reception 70 guests

THE MEREWETHER ROOM – THIRD FLOOR

Views from this room are across the Harbour and Botanic Gardens.

Dinner 24 guests
Cocktail Reception 40 guests

THE LIBRARY – THIRD FLOOR

Views from this room are across the Harbour and Botanic Gardens.

The Library may be reserved in the evening for dinners and receptions.
