FITNESS CENTER & SQUASH COURTS

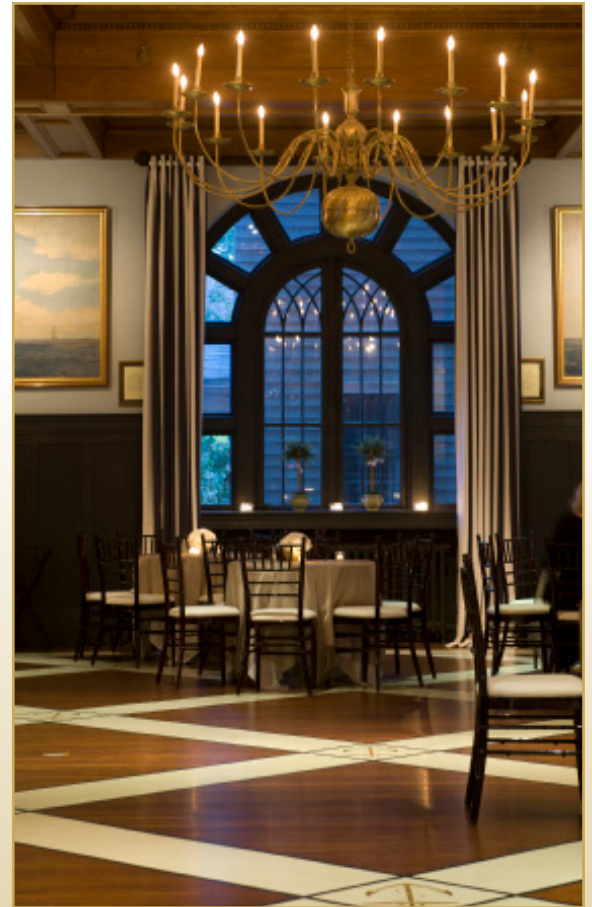
